

Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf Most important to note are the following:

- Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
- 2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

The closing date and time may be any time prior to the event, including the same day, and must be included in the premium list.

The Pee Wee Event is for children from the ages of 5 to under 9 years of age. Each Pee Wee class consists of the child and a responsible adult which must be in the ring with the Pee Wee. The dog must be at least 4 months of age and have the proper lead and collar. At an All-Breed event, all AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing. In addition, FSS breeds and All-American dogs may be allowed at the discretion of the Club. The responsible adult is responsible for the control of the dog outside the ring. Clubs must provide an additional lead if the mentor inside the ring feels that it is necessary for the safety of the dog and the Pee Wee. Building Access & Grooming Information

Exhibitors may enter Gate #5 at the show site from 12:00 Noon on Wednesday and all vehicles and dogs must be removed from the show site at the end of the show on Monday.

Vendors may enter Gate #7 at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday.

Exhibitors and Vendors may enter Gate # 5 at 6:00 A.M. Daily.

Show Buildings will open at 7:00 A.M. Daily.

No bathing of dogs inside of bathroom shower facilities.

No space may be saved for others. Exhibitors must establish a grooming area no larger than the immediate needs for the number of dogs being exhibited. Excessive grooming areas may be reduced by the event committee. Stacking of crates may be required.

No dogs left unattended on grooming tables.

Exhibitors and handlers are responsible to maintain clean conditions in their grooming area. You must clean up after your dogs in outside areas. Clean and courteous behavior will help ensure future use of these facilities.

No private exercise pens are permitted inside the building, in front or around the building or in the grooming areas.

No crating in Building except ringside crating is allowed 15 minutes before judging and must be removed 15 minutes after breed judging. Crates have to be in designated area and must be attended at all times except when the exhibitor is in the ring. No grooming is allowed ringside. Crates left at ringside when breed judging is over will be removed by the Event Committee.

Motels have been asked to notify us of any damages. The clubs will convene an Event Committee Hearing to deal with refusal to follow instructions, and we will recommend suspension for anyone found guilty of serious offenses.

Notice

All persons attending these dog show events hereby waive any claim for damage against the clubs or their members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. Grooming Areas & Stall Rental

Enter Gate #5 for grooming areas.

There is **Free Grooming on concrete under permanent cover near Davis Building**. However space and electricity are limited.

Also located between the Davis and Expo Buildings will be a large tent equipped with electric for grooming. Please be prepared to stack your crates. The Event Committee reserves the right to condense space if it should become necessary. Please leave aisles open. No private x-pens allowed in grooming area.

OUTER PAVED STALL RENTAL: The fee to rent a **level paved OUTER stall** for the five-day show circuit is **\$60.00**. **These stalls have electrical access.** Dogs may be left in the stalls overnight. You may bring your own locks and floor covering.

NOTE REGARDING STALL PARKING: By Orders of the Fire Marshal there will be NO PARKING at any of the Stalls!! You may unload and move your vehicle to a space in the parking lot. Vehicles may be towed if left by the stalls. No vehicle may be left unattended while loading or unloading.

INNER STALL RENTAL: There will be a limited number of inner stalls with electrical access available if needed with uneven hard clay flooring and dim lighting. Grooming may be done just outside of stalls. You are encouraged to bring your own ground cover and locks for the stalls. These stalls will be rented for \$40.00 for the five-day circuit.

As the Agricultural Center charges the Kennel Club for use of each stall, absolutely no one will be allowed to set up in the stalls or use electrical outlets in the stalls without paying the rental fee. The reserved grooming area will be policed for violations.

OUTER UNPAYED STALL RENTAL: These stalls have uneven hard clay floors. Grooming may be done under overhang outside of stalls. You are encouraged to bring ground cover and locks for your stalls. These stalls can be rented for \$45.00 for the five day circuit.

PORTABLE STALLS ON CONCRETE: These stalls will have electrical access and can be locked and they will be rented for \$50.00 for the five-day circuit.





Judge: Mr. Douglas E. Broadfoot Entry Fee: \$22.00 Futurity Guidelines

1. Purpose

To encourage the breeding of the best possible Black and Tan Coonhounds and to reward the breeders for their efforts. Thus the Futurity Stake is weighted towards the breeder. Recognition is also given the owners in whose hands lie the responsibility of developing the inherited potentialities. The sire is recognized for his genetic contribution.

2. General

- A. Correct and timely nominations of both the litter and the individual puppy are required for stake eligibility.
- B. Prize monies can only be won through competition in stake judging.
- C. Nominations forms may be secured from the Futurity Director.

3. Nomination of Litter

A. Must be by Breeder, or Co-Breeder, who must have been a member of the AB&TCC, in good standing, for at least a six month period immediately preceding the date of nomination. The nominator, if living must also be an AB&TCC member at the time of stake judging.

- B. Must be made after the breeding, but before the puppies are whelped. Postmark on envelope transmitting nomination establishes date of nomination.
- C. Fee is \$10.00 There will be no refunds.
- D. Nomination of litter makes each puppy in litter eligible for individual nomination.
- E. Late Litter Nominations Modification to guidelines as of May 2022
- Late nomination for litters can be made after the bitch has whelped by submitting a fee os \$25.00. The
 puppies may then be nominated in the usual manner before they reach 4 months of age. (Modification to
 guidelines April 2002)
- 4. Nomination of Puppy
- A. Must be owner, who need not be an AB&TCC member.
- B. Must be before puppy reaches four (4) months of age. Postmark on envelope transmitting nomination establishes date of nomination.
- C. Fee is \$10.00 for each nomination. There will be no refunds.
- D. An entire litter may be individually nominated by paying fee for each puppy and supplying whelping date, name and sex for each puppy. If either litter registration number nor individual registration number is available at time of nomination, this must be supplied as soon as available and in no case later than four (4) weeks before the stake judging. (Modification to guidelines April 2022).
- E. Any changes in the indentifying information which will be included in the Futurity or AB&TCC Specialty Show catalog from that previously provided the Futurity Director must be received by the Futurity Director no later than four (4) weeks before the stake judging. Failure to provide such information will result in disuqalification. (Modification to guidelines April 2022).
- F. Late Nominations Modification to guidelines as of April 2022

Late nominations can be made for puppies which have missed the deadline but whose litter was properly nominated by submitting a fee os \$25.00. This must be done no later than 4 weeks before the Futurity Stake judging. Postmark on the envelope transmitting the nomination establishes the date of nomination. This nomination must be done by the owner, who need not be an ABTCC member. The nomination must be submitted on the proper form, with the puppy's name and registration number recorded. There will be no refunds.

Late nominations van be made for puppies which have missed the deadline and whose litter was NOT nominated by the breeder submitting a late nomination fee for the bitch of \$25.00 AND the owner of the puppy submitting a late puppy nomination fee of \$25.00 as well. Both nominations must be made no later than 4 weeks before the Futurity Stake judging. Postmark on the envelope transmitting the nomination establishes the date of nomination. The breeder must be a member in good standing of the ABTCC for at least a 6-month period preceding the nomination. The puppy owner need not be a member of the ABTCC. There will be no refunds.

5. Entry for Stake Judging

- A. Must be entered in one of the regular classes, either conformation or obedience, at the AB&TCC Specialty Show and Obedience Trial. Fee for this entry must be paid.
- B. Futurity Stake entry must be indicated as an additional entry.
- C. Additional class entry must include age division (e.g. Futurity 6-9). Puppies are eligible only for the Futurity Stake, which is in conjunction with the first AB&TCC Specialty Show held on or after the date they reach six (6) months of age.
- D. The puppy must be Owner or Breeder handled during the Stake Judging for the Futurity class the puppy is entered in. Under special circumstances, another member of the ABTCC may be permitted to show the puppy in the initial Futurity class, with prior written permission of the Futurity Chair. The Puppy may be handled by another individual in the remaining competition should the puppy win its class.

6. Class Divisions

A. Stake is divided into four age divisions:

10100- Puppy Division, 10900- 6 months & Under 9 months 10100- Puppy Division, 11000- 9 months & Under 12 months 10200- Junior Division, 11400- 12 months & Under 15 months 10200- Junior Division, 44400- 15 months & over

- B. Each age division is further divided by sex. Thus there are two (2) classes in each age divisions.
- C. Four (4) placements are made in the judging of each class.
- 7. Sequence of Judging
- A. 6-9 puppy dogs, 6-9 puppy bitches
- B. 9-12 puppy dogs, 9-12 puppy bitches
- C. The first place winners from the 6-9 puppy dog & puppy bitch classes, and the first place winners from 9-12 dog & puppy bitch classes then re-enter the ring to compete for Best Futurity Puppy.
- D. 12-15 junior dog, 12-15 junior bitches

- E. 15 & over dogs & 15 & over bitches
- F. The first place winners from the 12-15 junior dogs & junior bitches, & the first place winners from the 15 over dogs & bitches then re-enter the ring to compete for Best Futurity Junior.
- G. The Best Futurity Puppy & the Best Futurity Junior then compete for Grand Prize Futurity Winner.

8. Division of Total Futurity Stake Monies

- A. Puppy Nomination Fees
- 1. 15% to be kept for general operating expenses.
- 2. 15% to the Grand Prize Futurity Winner.
- 3. 10% to the Best Futurity Junior.
- 4. 10% to the Best Futurity Puppy.
- 5. The remaining 50% to be divided equally among those participating in the ring.
- B. Bitch Nomination Fees
- 1. 10% to be kept for the general operating expenses.
- 2. 60% to the Breeder of the Grand Prize Winner.
- 3. 30% to the owner of the sire of the Grand Prize Winner.

9. Trophies and Ribbons

- A. A trophy and a rosette will be provided for the Best Futurity Puppy, the Best Futurity Junior and the Grand Prize Futurity winners from Futurity operating funds.
- B. Other trophies and rosettes may be awarded at discretion of the national Specialty Bench show committee.
- C. Ribbons are awarded for each placement.

10. Records

It is recommended those who have made entries in the Futurity have copies of all pertinent correspondence regarding acceptance of nominations, name changes, etc. available at the time of judging.

Summary of Major Rules

- Litter must be nominated by AB&TCC member breeder before it is whelped. If the bitch is not nominated prior to whelping a late fee will apply (please note Section 4F of the guideline). Modification to guidelines as of April 2002).
- Puppy must be nominated by owner, before it reaches four (4) months of age Owner need not be member of AB&TCC. If the puppy is not nominated before it reaches four (4) months of age a late fee will apply providing the bitch has been nominated (please note Section 4F of the quideline). Modification to guidelines as of April 2002).
- Futurity is an additional class at the National Specialty, and entry form must so indicate. (No points towards Championship are awarded).
- 4. The puppy must be Owner or Breeder handled during the Stake Judging for the Futurity class the puppy is entered in. Under special circumstances, another member of the ABTCC may be permitted to show the puppy in the initial Futurity class, with prior written permission of the Futurity Chair. The Puppy may be handled by another individual in the remaining competition should the puppy win its class.
- All information on entry form for Stake judging must be consistent with that which has been supplied the Futurity Chairperson.

Futurity Chairperson Job Description

- Maintain an annual record of bitch nominations and funds collected the record should include the original nomination form submitted.
 - The Chairperson will sign and date when received, record the date of postmark on remittance envelope, make a copy after signing, keep original for club record, and mail the copy to the nominator.
- Maintain an annual record of puppy nominations and funds collected the record should include the original nomination form submitted.
 - The Chairperson will sign and date when received, record the date of the postmark on remittance envelope, make a copy after signing, keep original for club records and mail the copy to the nominator.
- Make available to interested persons, copies of the bitch and puppy nomination forms. The forms contain a summary of the major rules, and the nominator, by signing signifies that they are aware and understand the Futurity Guidelines.
- 4. Four (4) times a year, the nominations are to be listed in the Newsletter.
- A list of eligible dogs to be mailed to the Superintendent prior to closing, so only eligible dogs will be permitted to enter the class by the Superintendent.
- 6. Prior to the judging date, the Chairman is to figure the amount of money due to the participants. The Futurity Chairman is to forward to the Club Treasurer within two (2) weeks after the Futurity, the Award payments. The awards dispersal should include the names to who check(s) are to be written, along with the mailing addresses. Maintain an annual record of the results of the Futurity, including a marked catalog.


